




10 TIPS FOR NAVIGATING MCGILL'S WORLDCAT CATALOGUE


WorldCat is the main catalogue for McGill University's library collections, including print and electronic books, journals, articles and databases.

1. WorldCat can be searched via the MUHC Libraries website (www.muhclibraries.ca) by clicking on the "McGill Catalogue" tab of the Quick Search Box.




2. To search WorldCat directly, go to <http://mcgill.worldcat.org/>, enter your terms in the search box, and click on "Search". By default, WorldCat will search for each term separately. Consider using double quotes if you are searching for a specific expression (ex: "history of medicine").
3. Click on the "Advanced Search" link to restrict your search to a particular field (ex: title or author fields) or format (ex: journal, eBook).





4. By default, results are sorted by library (McGill University Library holdings will appear first) and relevance. Use the “Sort by” drop-down menu to sort by author, title or publication date.
5. Refine your results by selecting the appropriate format to the left of the screen. You can also refine your results by author, language, or year of publication.
6. Although McGill may own multiple editions of a book, WorldCat will only display one edition in the results page (**not necessarily the most current edition**). Click “View all editions” to view all available editions of a particular book, including e-Books.
7. To check on the availability of a print book, click on the title, or click on “Availability”. Note that while some McGill affiliated hospital libraries have their holdings listed in WorldCat, the MUHC Libraries do not.
8. Click on “View Now” to check the full text availability of an e-Book. Click on “View eBook” to access the full text (you will be asked to log in with your McGill username and password).



9. Click on the A-Z links located in WorldCat’s menu to bring up lists of the databases and electronic journals licensed to McGill University.
10. Save searches and create lists of materials by registering for a free WorldCat account.
